KEEPING CAQH CURRENT

Since 2007, MHN has obtained practitioners' credentialing information from CAQH ProView (formerly CAQH Universal Credentialing DataSource). CAQH notifies practitioners via email when updates are required to keep their profile current.

You will continue to receive reminders from MHN when you are due for recredentialing, however these will no longer include a "packet" to be returned. Instead, you simply need to update your profile on the CAQH website at <u>https://proview.caqh.org/</u>. If your CAQH profile is incomplete or your attestation has expired, we will be unable to access your credentialing information, so it's important that you act quickly when you receive update notices from CAQH.

Please note: MHN only accesses your CAQH profile when you are being credentialed.
